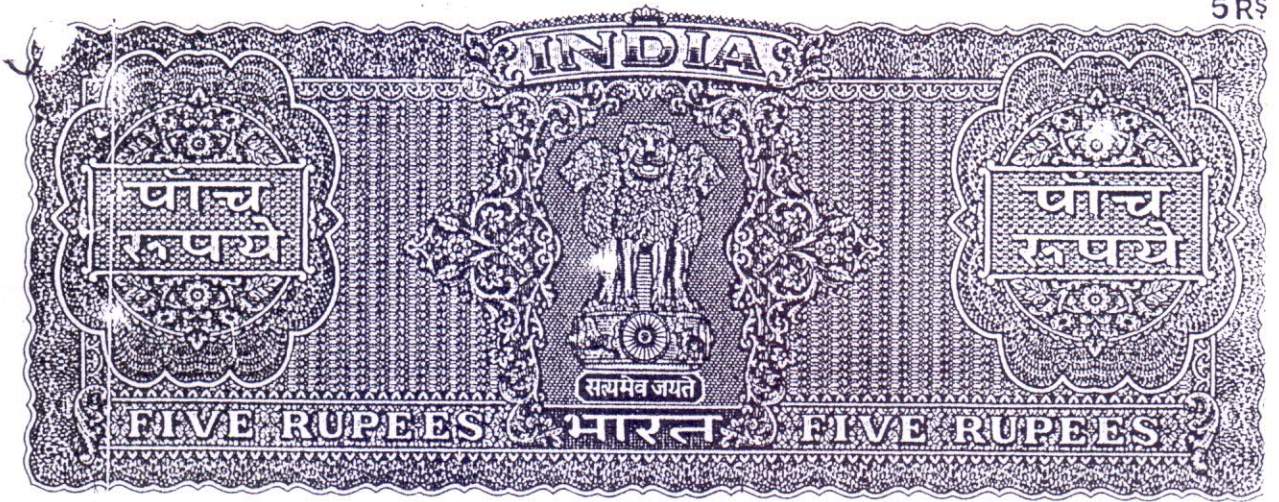

1. The name of the Charity shall be "SRI CHANDRAKANI GALANGALAPPA PATIL MEMORIAL PUBLIC CHARITABLE TRUST".



2. The object of the said trust shall be to acquire land in India, to construct thereon as institution for education or residence for students, a health resort, an Hospital, a Dharmashala Mangal Karyalaya or Community Hall and also the relief of the poor, education, medical relief and the advancement of the many other objects of general public utility in so far as the same relates to

anything done within the taxable territories, as defined under the Indian Income-tax Act, 1961, as amended from time to time without limiting to benefits hereof to any particular religious community. The Trustees shall have power to utilise not only the income but also the corpus or any part of the corpus of the charitable fund for any of the objects. The trustees shall have power to accumulate income out of the annual income of the Trust properties, for the objects of the Trust from time to time. Such accumulation of income shall be made as per the provisions of Section 11(2) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

3. If any person shall at any time hereafter offer to aid the charitable fund, hereby settled, whether by transfer of any immoveable property or movable property, or of Government or other securities or payment of cash in aid of any of the objects of the charity, hereby established, it shall be lawful for the trustees to accept the same upon such terms and conditions not inconsistent with any object of the charity, hereby constituted as the said trustees

may determine. Provided that in no case shall the name of the Charity hereby created be altered, in any manner whatever or its declared aims and objects departed from.

4. For the better and more uniform efficient and just administration of the said charity hereby constituted, it shall be lawful for the trustees from time to time ~~from~~ and make all necessary rules and regulations and by-laws not inconsistent with or repugnant to the said charity or its objects or any of the provisions hereof and from time to time add, to cancel or alter such rules, regulations and bye-laws as circumstances may require.

5. The Trustees shall invest charitable fund and all moneys liable to be invested under these presents except such parts thereof, as may be immediately required for the purpose of the said charity, in any of the securities authorised by law for the investment of trust moneys and may from time ^{to time} vary the said investments into or for others of the case for like nature provided that the Trust shall be entitled to retain any donations, in the form, in which they are given, without being liable for any loss resulting therefrom. Trustees will be entitled to invest or spend the charitable fund in construction of the buildings, required to carry out the objects of the trust mentioned in para 2 of this deed.

6. The number of Trustees shall be minimum five and maximum upto Eleven. Three trustees shall constitute aquorum when the trustees are five or less than five and five trustees shall form the quorum when the trustees are mor than five at any meeting of quorum

24. The Trustees shall have power to pay such remuneration, as they think fit, out of the charitable fund, to any trustees ~~or~~ trustee for the services rendered by him or them in connection with the administration and management of the Trust or Trust's Properties.

25. The Trustees may join, co-operate~~or~~ or amalgamate the trust of these presents or any portion thereof with any trust or institutions having allied or kindred objects upon such terms, as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and proper.

26. The Trustee shall have powers to alter add or amend any of the terms of these presents for the better and more efficient administration of the objects hereinafter prescribed but so that the objects prescribed by Clause 2 hereof shall not be capable of being altered or limited nor shall the Trustees have power to revoke these presents.

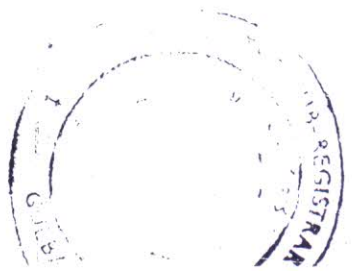

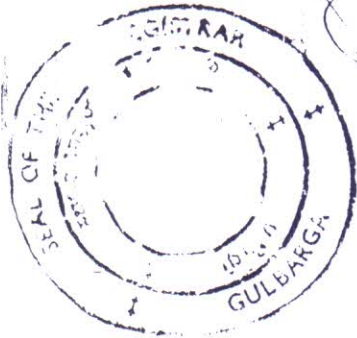
